Wilson's 14 Points (Wilsonian Idealism) → All the worlds as partners

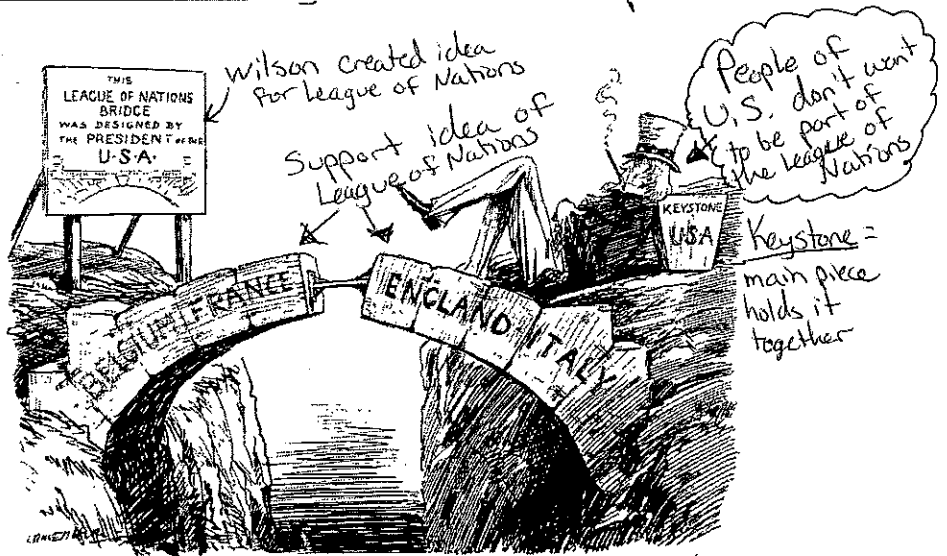
↳ Wilson's speech with 14 points → makes suggestions for peace

League of Nations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Created as part of the Treaty of Versailles Suggested by Wilson in the 14 points * Purpose: Forum for resolving international disputes

American Reaction:

- Return to Isolationism (don't get involved in world politics)
- People of U.S. didn't want to be part of the League of Nations
