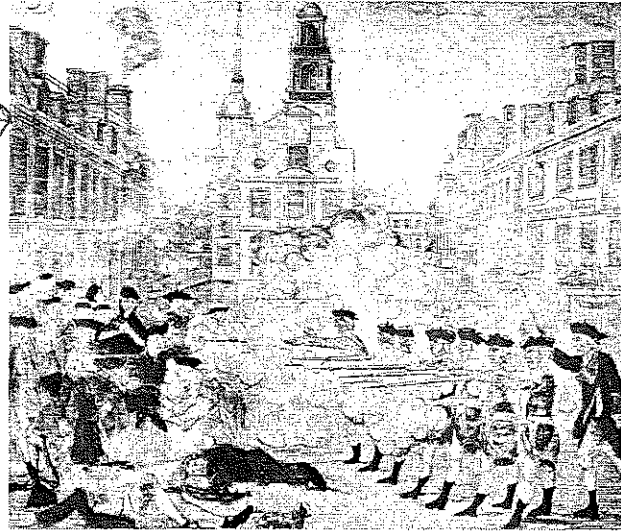

Reason #1: New and Unfair Taxes

British Tax	Restriction on Colonists	Effects
Stamp Act (1765)	- taxes on printed materials	- Protests ↳ Sons of Liberty formed as a result → often end up nothing
Townshend Acts (1767)	- taxes on tea and paper	- Boston Massacre - Boston Tea Party (1773)
Intolerable Acts (1774)	Response to Boston Tea Party ↳ Quartering Act ↳ British soldiers allowed to stay in your house	- First Continental Congress - King George sends British troops as result ↳ Everyone from Colonies want to start revolution

Reason #2: Boston Massacre

Riot	Massacre
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - violent protest - Both British & Colonist to blame - British act in self-defense (Captain Preston's opinion) (Loyalist) ↳ Loyal to King George III 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paul Revere ↳ His opinions created this - British soldiers killing innocent people/colonists (Patriot)



Reason #3: Boston Tea Party - making fun of British by calling it the "Tea Party"

Sons of Liberty ↓ Sam Adams (Patriot)	Townshend Act, Tea Act	Intolerable Acts First Continental Congress
